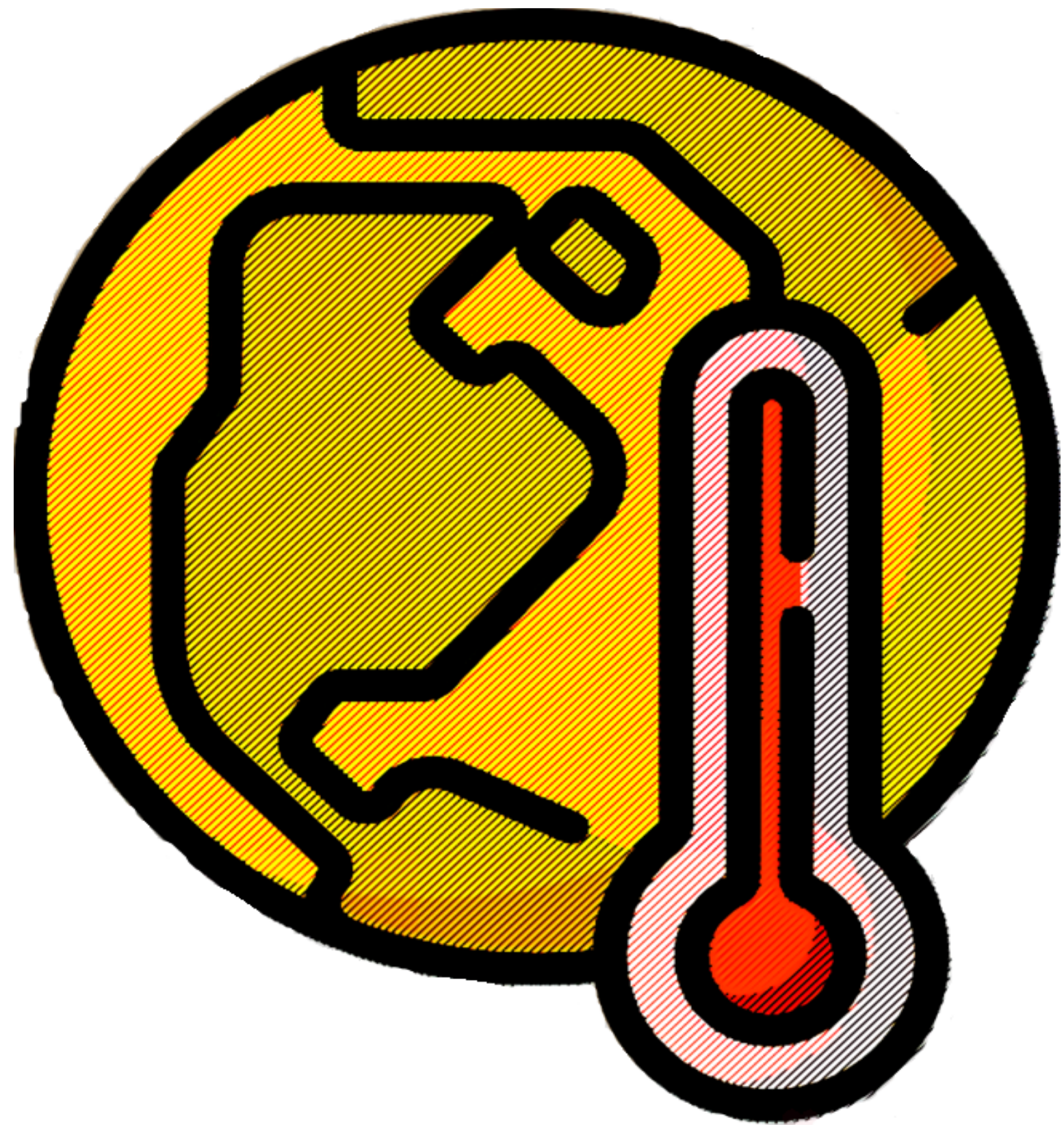

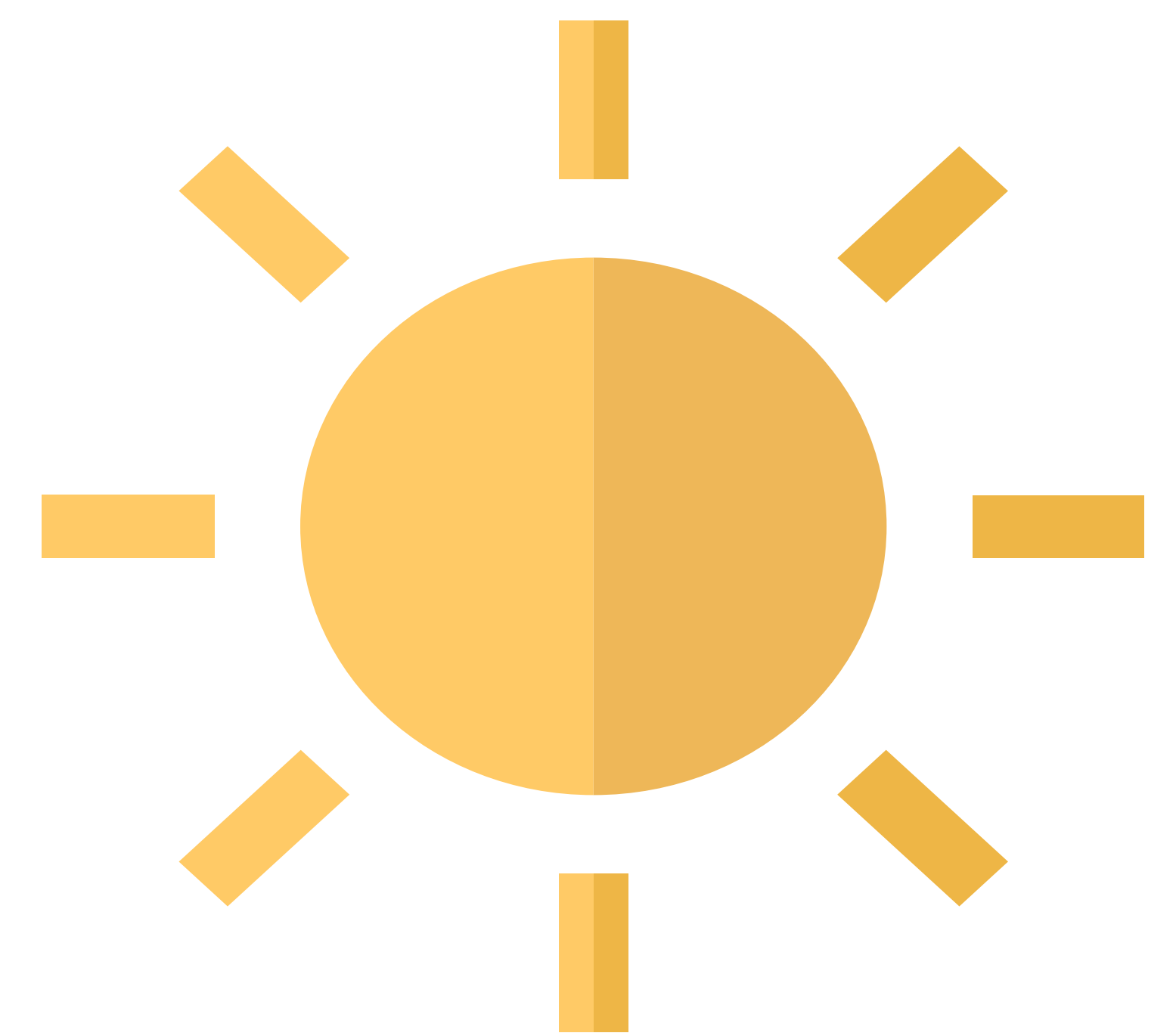
However, knowledge of climate change seems fragmented and not yet very well anchored in public opinion in Armenia.

Almost half of the population in regional cities have a delusion that climate change does not affect Armenia because it is a landlocked country.

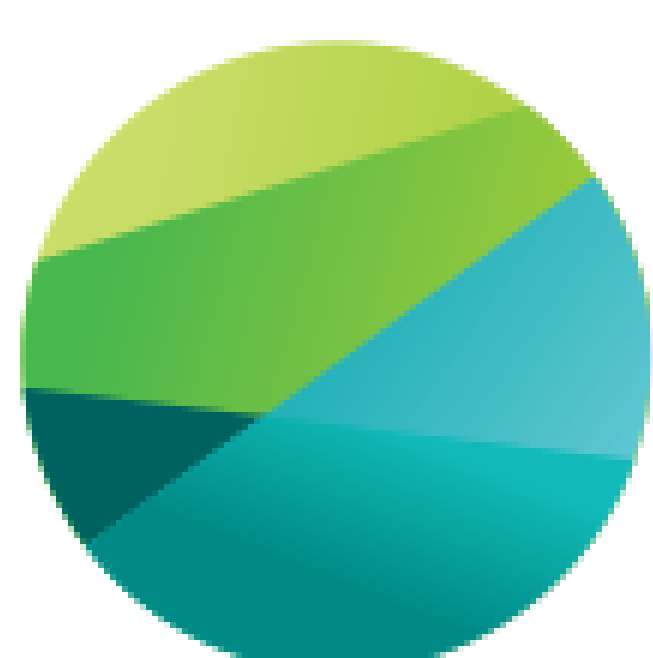
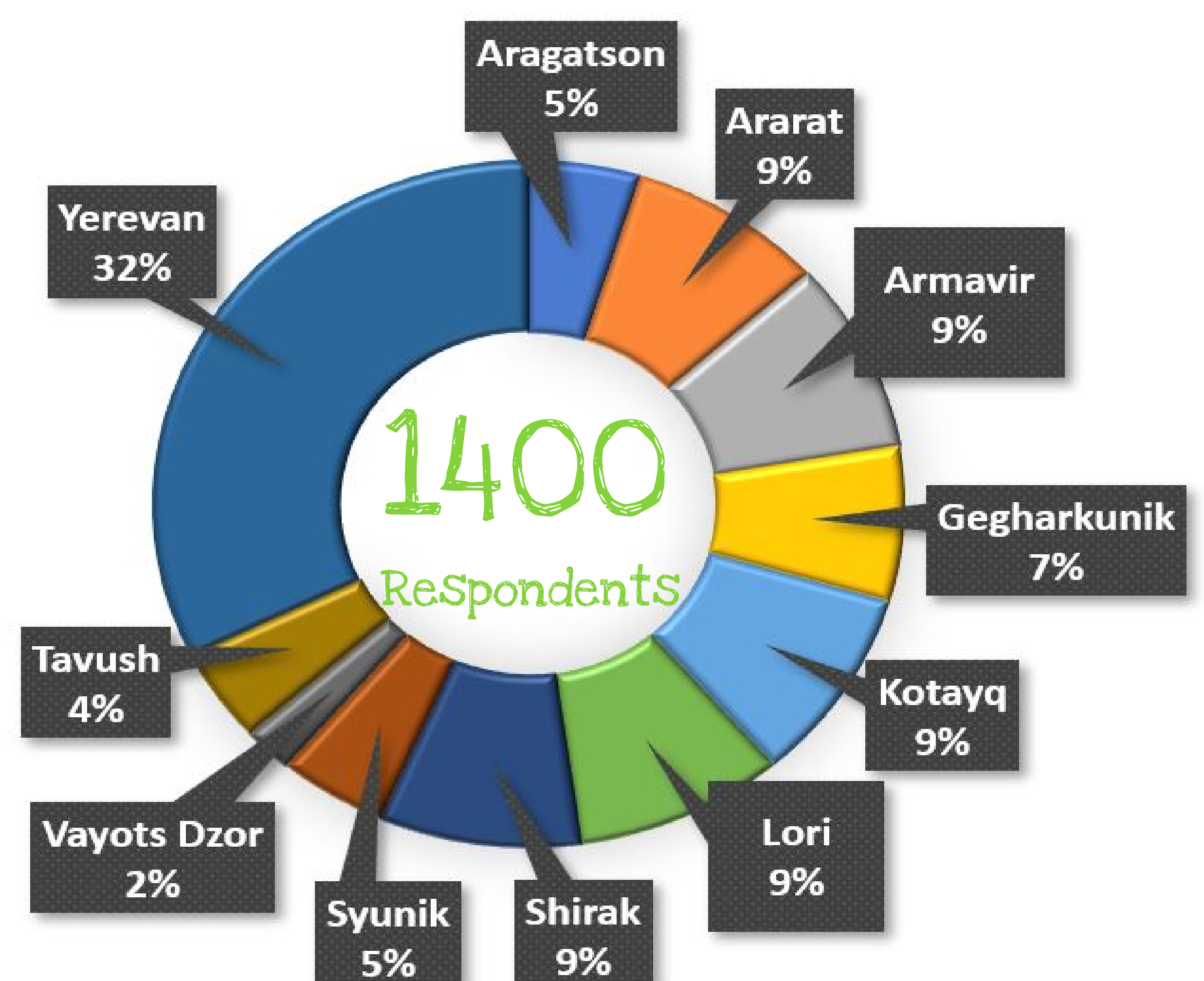
90% of respondents mistakenly believe that climate change = "weather change."



Almost half of the respondents believe that climate change will not lead to an increase in the frequency of storms, floods, and droughts in Armenia.
