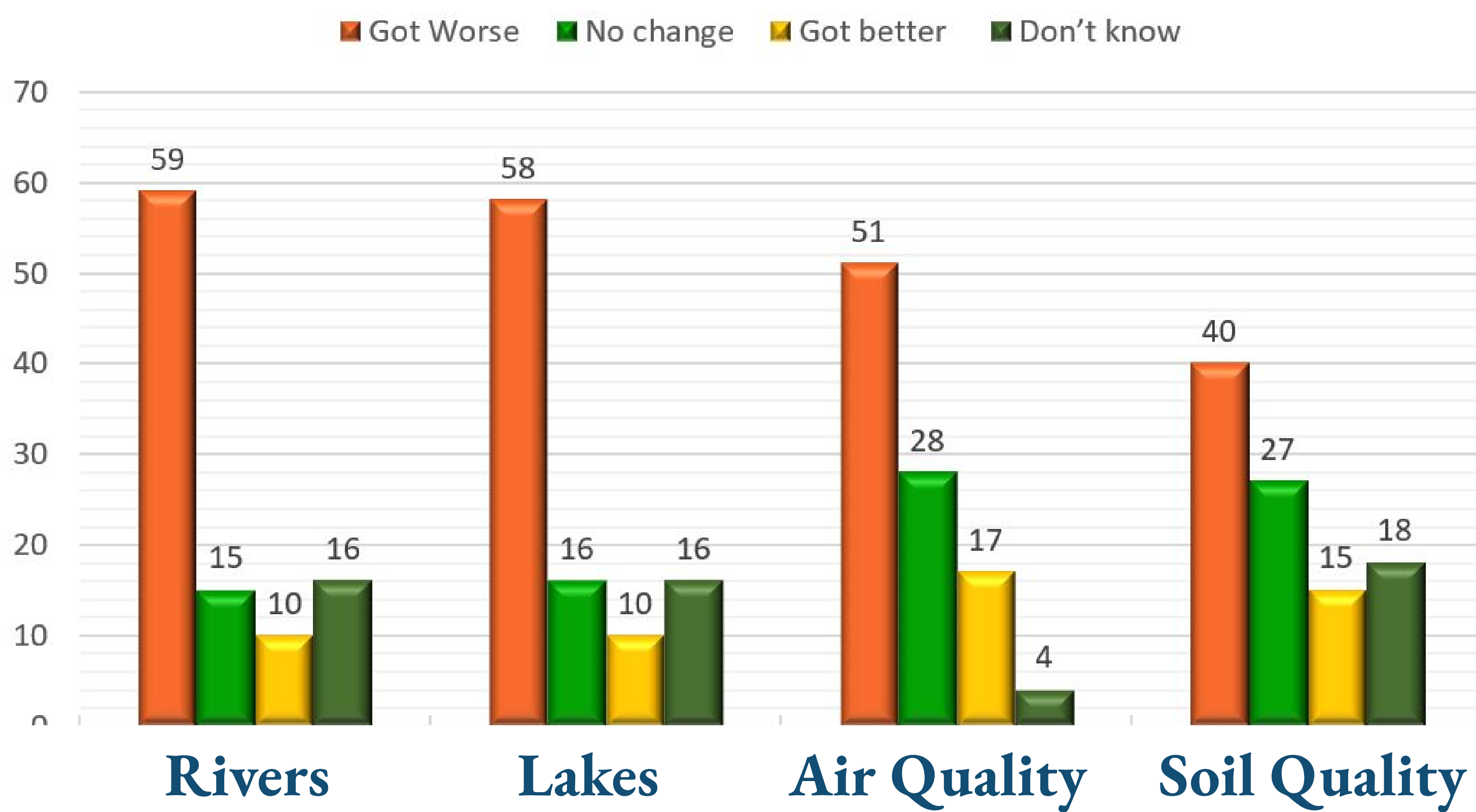

80% sees worsening or no change for the better

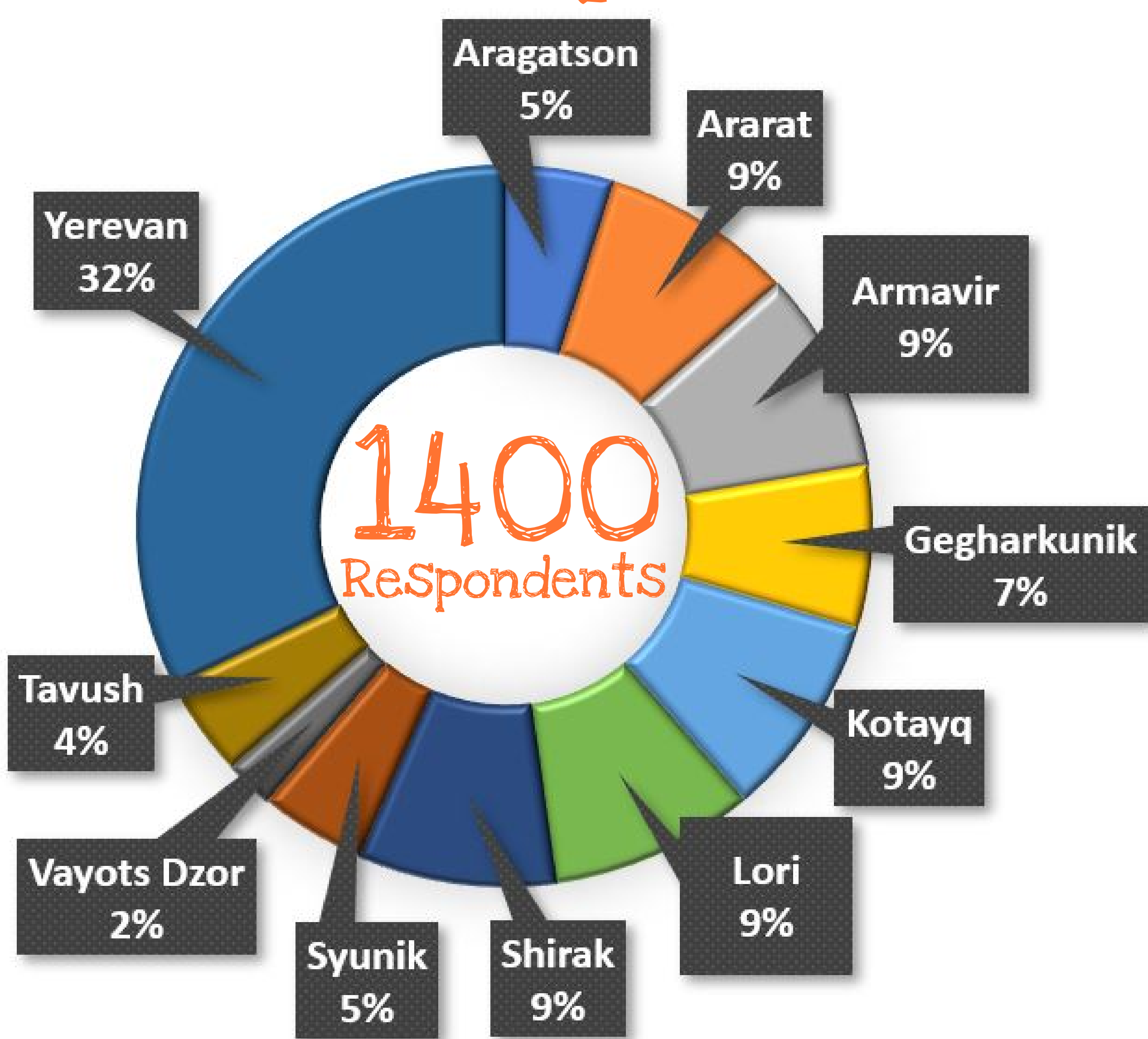
over the last 5-10 years related to the quality of natural resources

Environmentally Friendly Behavior and Priorities



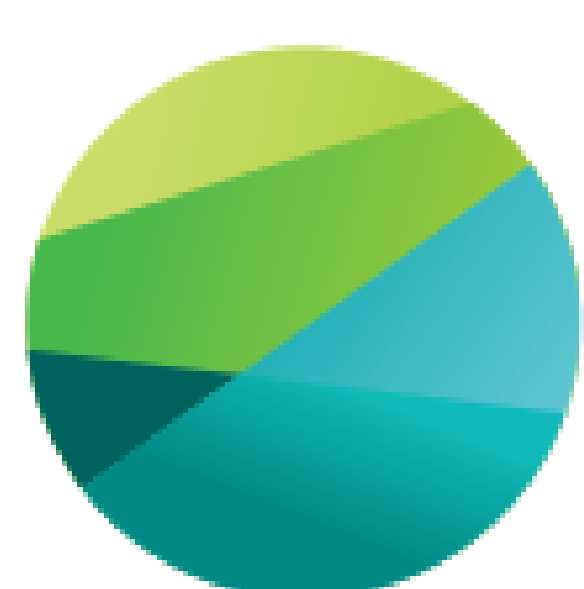

ALARMING FACTS

- ⚠ According to 37% "damaging the environment is justified if it brings an economic benefit"
- ⚠ 15% think that it is justified to eradicate animal species for human prosperity
- ⚠ Burning of leaves that contributes to air pollution is practiced by the majority of people in villages (56%)
- ⚠ The mitigation and adaptation to climate change is not considered as priority (less than 20%)
